I strongly object to the proposal of moving the part of Urmston to the East of the M60 into the Stretford ward for the following reasons:- 1) The difference in the number of electorate between Current Urmston to Proposed Urmston is negligible- The proposal takes out my area to the east of M60 and brings in a large part of Davyhulme east to the north. Also the difference in numbers between the Current Urmston to the Proposed Stretford is also negligible. Therefore in terms of numbers there is no point or argument. 2) One of the proposals aims is to ensure proposals reflect community ties and identities. [REDACTED]

In summary, I strongly object to Urmston east of M60 being moved into Stretford Ward. If this went ahead, then I would be reluctant to have a say in a community that I don't feel I belong, particularly when I tie in so strongly with the current Urmston Identity.
