Comment text:

I have just been made aware of the proposed amendment of Derby City ward boundaries. Having looked over these I am concerned that the changing of boundaries and the changing of ward names is going to be confusing and unsettling for members of the public. For many years I have lived in the Alvaston Ward and know the Ward boundaries and the local councillors. This boundary change is basically annexing a small area of the Alvaston ward to a very small select area whilst including within the new Wilmorton, Crewton and Osmaston a small annexed area of Osmaston! Wilmorton and Crewton have locally always been part of Alvaston whilst the area of Osmaston suggested to be included has always distinctly been part of Sinfin, a distinctly different political area. I'm really struggling to understand why these boundary changes are being suggested, current Wards have realistically alike numbers of voters between 9891 and 12908 whilst the overall number of voters 183,861 suggests Ward voter numbers should average 10815. It appears to me that these changes are not to the benefit of the public and changes should not be made to the boundaries.
