Comment text:

The area between Village Street and Sunnyhill Avenue is a homogeneous estate with similar demography throughout, which should remain as a unit within the Normanton Ward. It looks to Normanton for those shops and other local services and amenities not situated on the estate. Road and local public transport links to the City Centre and other centres of employment are via Normanton rather than Blagreaves. I therefore object to the proposal to transfer the part of Normanton Ward lying between the existing Ward boundary of Sunnyhill Avenue and the proposed boundary of Hathersage Avenue, Grange Avenue, Kitchener Avenue and Sinfin Lane into Blagreaves Ward. This area has no demographic affinity with Blagreaves, nor does it look to Blagreaves for shops and other local services and amenities, some of which are in the part of the estate you propose leaving in Normanton and others in the main Normanton area. Sunnyhill Avenue is a natural boundary, whereas the proposed boundary of Hathersage Avenue, Grange Avenue, Kitchener Avenue, Sinfin Lane is purely a line on the map with no local significance or distinct identity. Stenson Road also forms a natural boundary, but both sides of the road and the side turnings off it are a reasonably homogeneous area, and so could sensibly be put into Blagreaves, which would go some way towards increasing the population of Blagreaves Ward.
