### Comment text:

I'm not too keen on the proposed names for some of the 13 Wards in Hadleigh and Thundersley; Instead of Thundersley, I'd suggest St Peter's (which has links to the defeat of the Spanish Armada) Victoria should change to St Michael's which represents the social centre of Daws Heath. Hadleigh East is too bland; the famous {Grade 1 Listed} St James would be a more effective name. Hadleigh West as a ward name lacks personality though it is the centre of the borough; why not reflect a more historic aspect; Kiln Road or Mummery's would recall famous past aspects of the central ward. More interesting names could start to neutralise the past Castle Point Council negative ethos by: 1) setting more positive models of building communities with better services; e.g. lower carbon refurbishment of existing structures, increasing the number of meeting places; 2) encouraging more attractive structures with their roots in community history; 3) building housing with higher standards and improving public services for the whole borough; 4) ensuring sight lines are maintained or improved to the very few remaining interesting buildings.
