### Comment text:

As a resident of Wick I strongly object to the proposal of moving Wick out of the Fladbury Ward and into the Pershore Ward. Wick is a small, attractive rural village in a conservation area with a strong and thriving community. There are four working farms within the parish. The needs and interests of the village have been well served over many years by being in the Fladbury Ward as the villages in this ward have common concerns and similar identities. Pershore on the other hand is a rapidly growing town with light industries- the needs and interests of the town are in sharp contrast to that of Wick. Wick and Pershore are in different bands and so there are different planning regulations for both. Any changes to the consideration to planning now given under these terms to Wick would greatly affect the character of the village. By remaining in the Fladbury Ward Wick would still have good representation of their needs. With the growing population of Pershore being about 7 250 to the approximate 365 residents of Wick: with the huge disparity in numbers the needs of the village/ villagers would not be held in high consideration. It does not seem a logical proposal or of any benefit to Wick to be moved from the Fladbury Ward. I strongly recommend that Wick remain within the Fladbury Ward.
