Objection to proposed changes to Southern Parishes.

I have just learned that you have changed the proposed boundaries because Kirklevington wants more houses (around Green Lane) included in their area and doesn't want their Parish split.

As a consequence, you are proposing to split Maltby Parish to accommodate Kirklevington's wishes.

I think this is wholly unfair to Maltby and I don't understand how you feel it is OK to do that to a small Parish for the gain of Kirklevington!

I don't understand your thinking here as the houses around Green Lane are not close to Kirklevington, unlike those at Maltby Farm vs Maltby. I have a friend that lives in Leven Woods estate and they do not consider themselves part of Kirklevington and consider themselves Yarm residents, I believe others in that estate feel the same. I am exasperated to understand how you can think that this housing estate is a village????

Little Maltby shares the same shop, cricket/social pitch, pub with Maltby and to some extent Hilton and yet you feel it is appropriate to segregate Little Maltby/Maltby?

In the original proposal you talked about grouping VILLAGES together but what you are now proposing is including an extension of Yarm (albeit in the Kirklevington Parish). As a Hilton resident I am concerned that going forward as "Southern Parishes" our needs will not be met by the expanded Kirklevington as the houses in the Yarm area have different needs to our villages.

Hilton has more in common with Maltby/Maltby Farm as we share amenities as well as groups such as the WI. In fact, we can walk to Maltby/Little Maltby across the fields as it's only about 1 mile.

I agreed with your initial option as it made sense to group the Southern Villages together and move our village out of Ingleby Barwick.

I object to your new proposal and would like you to return to your original proposal as with what you are now proposing we might as well have stayed with Ingleby Barwick!!!

There are many people in Hilton that agreed with your original proposal but may not be aware that you have changed your minds as your timing of this (over Christmas) means many may not be aware.

Please revert to your original proposal and keep Southern Parishes as villages.
