Dear Sir/Madam

I am a resident of the Grangefield area of Stockton on Tees and I am completely against the proposal to abolish Grangefield.

Rather than abolish Grangefield can I suggest that you change to make it have a single member Councillor Ward and that it could be made up of Grange Estate and Newham Grange Estate. This ward would have a number of strong links including bus stops, St Pauls Church, the Institute on Grays Road and the local shops such as Sainsburys and Grangefield Road shop. You could if you felt it was necessary to make up the numbers you require also include Bramley Green Estate, Grangefield Academy, Stockton Cricket Club and Rugby Club, Stockton 6th Form College, Stockton Football Club and Nos 1 and 3 Bishopton Road West.

Can I suggest that Durham Road/Primrose Hill area should join the Town Centre Ward to make a three member Ward. The rationale behind this is that they share the same bus routes, Hebron church in New Town, shops, facilities and the housing is continuous.

Grangefield has nothing at all in common with Durham Road/Primrose Hill area of New Town and that my proposal of a single Councillor is the only realistic and workable solution and is necessary to make the numbers work for any change.

I am sure you will listen to the local objections to your proposed changes and that there will be a sensible solution forthcoming from you.
