I have heard from a neighbour that there is a proposal to change the ward where I live . I object strongly to this and wish to make my objections known.

[REDACTED] . I moved , with my husband, into this address 51 years ago, in January 1970. My youngest child was born here. I taught at Grangefield Comprehensive School for 27 years – holding my retirement presentation at Stockton Cricket Club. My children all attended Our Lady and St Bede's School. A sister-in-law lived in Oxbridge Avenue, I have a son living [n Windsor Road. I use Sainsbury's supermarket as my main shop.

I give you all this information to illustrate how much my life is embedded in the Grangefield area. I know nothing of Newtown. I do not know anyone living there, the names of the roads. I have no activities there other than picking up parcels from the large post depot when I have missed a delivery. When driving through, I am aware that much of the housing is terraced with little space for gardens. This housing is in contrast to the Grangefield housing which is predominantly semi-detached with large garden space. This difference will be reflected in the council tax paid.

So, I wish to register my strong disagreement to the proposal of moving Allendale Road and its immediate surrounding roads from its Grangefield ward to Newtown ward.
