### Comment text:

Single ward councillors will place an undue burden on those who represent a ward. Many of them also have other jobs and of course, will need to take away from their council duties owing to holidays, sickness, family commitments etc. It will also mean that we have micro wards where there will be less cohesion between one ward and a neighbouring one - in effect, turning Liverpool City Council into a parish council. Akin to saying all a councillor will have to do is to look after his/her own ward without regard to the bigger picture i.e. Liverpool as a city and as a council as a whole. However, I do think a councillor's four year tenure is much too long and would prefer to see councillors being elected on a three year rotational basis (as is now); or preferably, all councillors (all ninety of them) being up for election each year.
