To whom it may concern I live on Carnatic Road. Quite a famous road in Mossley Hill and well know amongst runners for its steep incline as it forms part of Mossley Hill. Imagine my surprise to discover that redrawing of ward boundaries would now mean my road forms part of Greenbank ward. I respectfully suggest, the boundary for Greenbank should be redrawn at Queens Drive and not Elmseod Road. I understand you wish to make the areas more balanced but Greenbank itself has issues with homes of multiple occupancy containing students and litter issues pertaining to students and businesses. The area south of Queens Drive is solely residential and has closer links with Mossley Hill and in-fac, postcode wise, is Mossley Hill! It would seem absurd to change the boundary/ward so that it is included in Greenbank instead. I strongly object as the current wards have different issues and merging carnatic into Greenbank will make more work for councillors rather than less. Please reconsider the boundary. Sometimes it is not just as simple as drawing a line on a map, there are issues and historical reasons which also need to be taken into account.
