I work in Brunswick and I feel it is important to keep it a separate ward to the current regency. The communities in the proposed Regency and Westdene and Hove Park are wrong as they connect communities which are not currently integrated with each other in terms of how they run local groups. Charles Busby's designed Brunswick to be a self-contained Town estate and while the city has grown around it there is a clear historic boundary that can be seen in the architecture that is distinct to the area. Brunswick Town is a conservation area and furthermore there are numerous local groups run by local Brunswick residents. Hove Park area has nothing in common with Westdene apart from the fact that they lean Tory. Hove Park is more connected with Hangleton and Westdene closer to Patcham. I live in Bevendean and I don't agree with adding in Saunders Park area to the Moulsecoomb & Bevendean Ward as it is much closer to the Hollingdean and Hannover communities due to where the local amenities are situated. The Lewes Road makes for a clear boundary more so than the trainline.
