My name is [REDACTED] and I respond to the draft recommendations from the Local Government Boundary Commission for the new electoral arrangements for Brighton & Hove City Council shown on this website I am completely opposed to the proposal to join Brunswick & Adelaide ward with Regency ward under the name of 'Regency' for the following reasons: • The loss of our ward representing the area that is the historic origins of current Hove & also complete loss of the historic Brighton/Hove border • There is a very strong community presence in Brunswick & Adelaide with 3 strong residents' associations, These 3 all have high levels of engagement from residents, demonstrating community interest and identity. Regency ward is mostly a commercial area where many of the property owners are not resident whereas by contrast, the Brunswick & Adelaide ward is an area consisting of residential squares, terraces, streets and crescents of Grade 1 & 2 listed buildings and incorporates a large conservation area. • The merging of a quiet residential area of central Hove with part of commercial Brighton (including the major shopping street of Western Road, all the seafront restaurants and bars, cinema & Brighton Centre) does not meet one of your three statutory criteria - 'reflecting community interests and identities'. I respectfully request you reject these proposed boundary changes to the Brunswick & Adelaide Ward and believe your proposal in respect of our ward will be of detriment to our community.
