Local Government Boundary Commission for England 1st Floor, Windsor House 50 Victoria Street London SW1H 0TL 8 April 2022 Dear Sir/Madam DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS for BRIGHTON and HOVE CITY COUNCIL I refer to the consultation on the Draft Recommendations for Brighton and Hove City Council, published by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 1 February 2022. I wholly endorse the document submitted to the consultation by [REDACTED] on 7 April 2022 and support the alternative ward boundaries she proposes. As a resident of Westdene, I highlight [REDACTED] proposals for a Westdene and Patcham ward and ask the commissioners to adopt her suggestion. The draft recommendations outline a ward named Westdene and Hove Park which has no meaning to me, as a resident of Westdene since the 1990s. I am a Brightonian and not a resident of Hove. When I go out socially or shopping, I go down into Westdene, Withdean, Patcham or Preston and into Brighton – not into Hove. As a keen golfer, I am a member at East Brighton Golf Club, not West Hove or the Dyke, because Westdene has public transport links into Brighton and not with Hove.
