Comment text:

I am a resident of Langton Avenue [REDACTED] since 62 years ago. I don't agree with proposals for Ewell & Nonsuch wards. The set and fixed railway line (Epsom to Sutton) has always been a barrier and forming the historical boundary of Ewell with Nonsuch (and College ward before that). To change and substitute the A24 as a boundary is not logical. I recollect reading the rationale for this was the dual carriageway of the A24. It seems not to have been realised that the dual carriageway of the A24/A240 terminates (travelling Southwards) at Homebase/Esso/Reigate Road roundabout, thereafter the road is single carriageway. That is where the proposals are not acceptable. All the roads off this section (including a short length of Reigate Road) namely, Beech Walk, St. James Avenue, Hampton Grove, Langton Avenue, Park Hill Road, Windmill Avenue are cul-de-sac due to the presence of the railway line. Exiting all these roads one is in Ewell NOT Nonsuch. Ewell Village centre is close by and the residents have always had an affinity with that, Nonsuch is a large ward with no centre and the residents of these roads all have regarded as being in Ewell, not Nonsuch. Additionally, I strongly believe at the recent development of Sycamore Gardens is close to and has the same affinity with Ewell, not Nonsuch and that estate should be within Ewell rather than Nonsuch.
