Dear Sir / Madam Just one small, but important suggestion, or a correction to what I think must be a mistake. Please realign the eastern constituency boundary at Black Rock to include all the residences of Black Rock. To follow Boundary Road, running from Marine Drive to Roedean Road, which utilises the historic Brighton Borough boundary\*, thus retaining the cultural integrity of the past and our local democracy, not isolating Arundel Street detached from its immediate neighbourhood of De Courcel, Arundel and Eastern Roads, Arundel and Eastern Place. Also, the proposed boundary actually cuts off the end of Eastern Road, which does not make sense either. I have attached an amended boundary line to your map of this area so the recommendation is clear.

\* NB at the northern junction of the red line (see the attached map) is the protected (grade 2 listed "building") boundary stone, which should be an integral part of the boundary, in keeping with the past and more fitting for the future than the draft proposed boundary.
