Comment text:

The current ward and community of Patcham must not be split in two as per the current proposal. This disregards the commissions own ambition in not dividing communities and pays little regard to the history of the area that came in to force when Patcham expanded in the 1820’s. This is where the original village and the ladies mile estate (including Mackie avenue) became one. The current proposal also disregards of only takes a two dimensional view of the area, in which the Mackie avenue and all side roads have no road connection with Carden or hollingbury. You would have to go through Westdene and Patcham ward to reconnect to the rest of the ward! Over half of Patcham would be in a new ward that does not even recognise its name. Carden is merely a road and not an area.
