Comment text:

The draft recommendations for Rushcliffe move Scarrington out of the Cranmer group with which it shares many common interests both culturally and historically. This is disappointing but it's new position in the East Bridgford Ward reflects an understanding of a similar rural outlook and aspiration unlike a move into the Bingham North ward in the further draft proposals. This proposal is very unsatisfactory as it's population is largely suburban as opposed to rural and I fear the representation of the interests of a small village will be lost in a largely town oriented voice. Scarrington can have less than 150 voters, it should be positioned in a ward that reflects it's character, and arguments about balancing numbers have no place given the rapid expansion in the population of voters from extensive housing growth in north Bingham. Scarrington must stay in a rural ward.
