**Re :- Parish and District Boundary Changes**

Hampton Lovett & Westwood Parish Council wrote to you on the 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022 at which time we included what we considered to be an extremely well put together document which was produced by the Residents of Doverdale Park Homes representing 156 voters as you had asked in particular for further evidence from Residence of Doverdale Park Homes this being on page 13 paragraph 52 of the Local Government Boundary Commission changes submitted to us in early January.

We have tried to submit to you comments without over lapping the hard work which has been put forward by the individuals concerned so that you should have received the comments you requested from the residents of Doverdale Park Homes those of the Councillor on the Parish Council representing Doverdale Park Homes, the Parish Council the District Council, and the County Council. Thus to re-inforce this, this letter is signed by Paul Speechley Chairman and Kenneth Jacques Secretary of Doverdale Park Homes Cllr.Christine Ellson Evans the elected Parish Cllr, Cllr G.D. Crow Chairman Hampton Lovett and Westwood Parish Council, Cllr.Nicolas Wright the District Councillor for this area, Cllr. Tony Miller County Councillor covering our area and Cabinet Chairman for Worcestershire Environmental services. We are forwarding this letter in an endeavour to put over to The Local Government Boundary Commission for England that the whole of the local Councillor control is totally against the proposed changes to the Hampton Lovett & Westwood Parish Council Boundary.

There is however no resistance to Hampton Lovett and Westwood Parish Council working with Doverdale and Ombersley Parish Council. Provided the relationship remains the same as the current relationship between Hampton Lovett and Westwood and North Claines Parish Council as at present. Within the documents supplied the points for the objection to the changes suggested to add Doverdale Park Homes to Droitwich West are well documented to you.



It is however felt by all concerned that for a document that should be "A political" the requirements for the Liberal Party at face value appears to have had considerable influence particularly in the area concerned where there is a very small representation from any Liberal Candidates. The due diligence has taken no regard to the demographic of Doverdale Park Homes and Westlands Estate in Droitwich West.

You have provided two Councillors for the people in an area you have called Wassage they are not shown on any Electoral role you have removed two Councillors out of Westwood and yet that has not changed in any way. There are many more of these misrepresentation details which brings into doubt and question the thinking behind the proposed changes.
