### Comment text:

I am a resident of Great Comberton and strongly object to the boundary changes proposed. This village has strong ties to Little Comberton and Elmley Castle and does not have any comparisons to Eckington. Size wise, amenities etc. this village is completely at odds, not to mention the fact that it is an ANOB. The three villages have always been linked because of their close proximity to Bredon Hill something which does not apply to Eckington, therefore have entirely different views regarding how the parishes operate and also their requirements. Size matters and comparing Great Comberton to Eckington is like comparing chalk to cheese. It (Eckington) is not in the Cotswold Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. I am sure that when planning applications are considered, development has to take all things into account, Eckington has grown out of all recognition, when all factors are considered linking the two villages seems to be most inappropriate as Natural England and the ANOB would not look favorably on this union.
