Comment text:

It is time that a serious review of local government took place and radical modernisation implemented for all of Worcestershire. As has been shown in the Local Authority reaction and participation in the Local Resilience Forum the County Council led Worcestershire's reaction to the pandemic, not the District Councils. District Councils are superfluous to requirements in a county of 550,000 - 600,000 people and an unnecessary financial burden. We have Parish Councils and our market towns have a very effective group of Town Clerks and Mayors, so we do not need an additional intermediate tier of district councillors. Worcestershire should become a Unitary council as soon as possible and not waste time tinkering with District Council ward boundaries to save a couple of Councillors.
