Comment text:

I have three areas of concern with the divisions surrounding Shrewsbury: 1. Tern combines villages on opposite sides of the town which have nothing in common and little contact with each other. It is in essence a "semi doughnut ward" with many of the downsides mentioned in the technical guide. Bomere in the north has far more to do with Baschurch, Myddle and Montford Bridge (school and policing areas etc); Upton Magna etc in the east with the Atcham area. I appreciate the arithmetic may make it tricky, but this division makes no community sense. 2. The north-western boundary of Severn Valley needs moving south to include more areas in the Bayston Hill etc division (and hopefully within the town council and new parliamentary seat in due course). It beggars belief that new Shrewsbury housing estates will sit in the South Shropshire seat because of this division crossing the A5. 3. Although again the arithmetic makes it difficult, I sympathise with people in Bayston Hill who object to being in a multi-member seat with a large chunk of Shrewsbury. I would consider a single member Bayston Hill seat, or if the numbers don't allow, a two-member seat with Longden (or another neighbouring non-town division).
