I oppose the suggested boundary changes to omit Fulmer from Gerrards Cross. I have lived here for over six years and all the shopping, leisure and other local amenities that we use are based in Gerrards Cross. I have little reason to go to Hedgerley, Wexham and Farnham as access is not as direct nor do they provide the same level of facilities found in Gerrards Cross. Having a SL3 postcode already lumbars us with Slough in Berkshire rather than Buckinghamshire. Whenever, you give your postcode you are already labelled as being in the wrong County. I think making arbitrary boundary changes just to "balance up the numbers" is not constructive and in fact detrimental. All the time we are being encouraged to develop local Communities within a on-line world but these proposals just destroy any existing sense of Community. Existing boundaries may be changed but residents will continue to follow the established or historic ways which developed these areas into local Communities in the first place.
