Writing as a Desborough resident and with proposed development, I believe from a Town Council perspective there should now be three wards, being St Giles, Loatlands and Weavers Mead/Grange with four town councillors serving each ward. On the Unitary Council I believe Desborough requires a reduction from three to two councillors. My reasoning being there appears to be only ONE that is actually visibly active in the town and attends the Town Council meetings. This reduction aligns to the proposed reduction to 60 unitary councillors overall. I have the same view on neighbours at Rothwell. Having said this, I would then have one unitary councillors for the villages of Stoke Albany, Weston by Welland, Ashley, Brampton Ash and Dingley, moving Braybrooke into Rothwell division where there would also be two unitary positions. I think there's an opportunity to place Wilbarston, East Carlton, Middleton, Cottingham and Pipewell into one division- keeping Rushton in the Rothwell division. I'd move the area of the current Kettering business park out of Rushton and into Kettering Town ward. Storefield Cottages could be moved into Newton & Little Oakley ward. All of this being a personal view.
