Soldiers Rise [redacted] has been part of Finchampstead for a long time Then in the 1909's in order to rebalance voting numbers we were asked to vote in Wokingham Without parish whilst still paying our Council Tax to Finchampstead. Soldiers Rise would sit at the extreme western side of WW Parish, over the railway line and is separated from the main Wokingham Without residential groups by large areas of green space. Soldiers Rise has no association with the settlements within WW parish, however does have association with the eastern residential settlement with Finchampstead. the appears to be clear reasoning for the transfer particularly as WW parish has been significantly developed to increase the population which will increase again with the development south of the main railway line in Wokingham.
