I have long felt completely unrepresented at District Council level. We have nothing in common with the Forest which sees itself as centred around the administrative HQ Coleford and it's immediate environs.
We have lived here over 20 years and have visited Coleford perhaps twice. Our Council Tax money is currently being used for development projects such as their shopping precinct and 5 Acres sites none of which will be of any benefit to our communities whatsoever.
Our communities of Hartpury, Corse, Ashleworth, Maisemore, and the smaller villages have much in common with each other and are more closely related to Newent and even Highnam. Our concerns over schooling, transport, housing, and support services such as doctors & dentists are not well served from Coleford. And issues such as flooding on the A417 at Maisemore simply does not affect them at all.
