**Related subject:** Higham Ferrers, Permberton, Rushden Lakes and Rushden South

With reference to the report para 76 refers to both conservative groups identifying few distinctions of community identify within the town of Rushden and the key distinction being the boundary between Rushden and Higham Ferrers. The proposal follows the parish boundary but with the adoption of Prospect Avenue, Firdale Avenue, The Hedges and St James Close within Higham Ferrers. This is supported but with this adoption the Council would contest the same circumstances apply to the boundary by Shelley Drive. At present the parish boundary divides Shelley Drive, Larkin Gardens and Elliot Way. The Council propose the boundary be extended to include these streets in the Higham Ferrers ward and that of Donne Close too. These streets share a community identify as much as Prospect Avenue and The Hedges area. The streets sit to the north of Northampton Road which the Council suggest forms a more appropriate boundary between Higham Ferrers and Rushden. Northampton Road is already the parish boundary to the point where it meets Shelley Drive. The council propose the boundary continues along Northampton Road to allow the incorporation of these streets in the Higham Ferrers ward.
