I am writing to object to the proposal to join Tatsfield & Titsey Ward with Limpsfield. Despite being served by SCC and TDC, Tatsfield is very much 'out on a limb' being bordered by both Kent and LBB. Tatsfield has many unique situations that require careful handling, for instance: Tatsfield residents do not have the choice of a Surrey GP and have to sign up with either a Westerham or Biggin Hill practice. This fact and the bus service favours travel towards Biggin Hill and Bromley which impacts where people shop and work. At it's northern border there is no visible boundary between Tatsfield and Biggin Hill whereas Tatsfield and Limpsfield are separated by more than two miles of open countryside. Tatsfield therefore has a distinct identity which is very different from that of Limpsfield. The electorate in Tatsfield is a third of that of Limpsfield, Tatsfield would therefore be a minority interest. At present, we are more than adequately represented by Councillor Allen and previously by Councillor Bob David who as residents of Tatsfield understand the issues that impact Tatsfield. The commission suggests that Woldingham's identity justifies retaining a one member ward. Tatsfield & Titsey have a similar electorate and identity and should therefore be subject to the same consideration.
