Related subject: Splitting Adderley Parish into wards

At their recent meeting Adderley Parish Council discussed the fact that the recommendation in this review was to spilt Adderley into two wards with the larger part in the north still under the Prees Unitary Cllr and the smaller Western Way part in the south being represented by the Unitary Cllr for Market Drayton East. The Council were unanimous in their decision that this recommendation was not what they wanted and would not benefit to the Parish of Adderley at all. The Council were very concerned that there would be a conflict of interests between a Unitary Cllr whose area mostly covered the Market Drayton area. The Council also wondered if the review had considered that the Western Way area included an area of land ear-marked for development within Shropshire Council's emerging Local Plan and would see another 126 dwellings in this area. As a planning application has already been made regarding this land the Council is sure that as soon as the Local Plan is signed off by Shropshire Council this area will be developed very quickly. The Parish Council went on to support Norton in Hales Parish Council regarding their proposal that it too should be represented by the Unitary Cllr for Prees alongside Adderley and Moreton Say as they have been working together on the Three Parish Neighbourhood Plan which is now entering the final stage of the process
