## Comment text:

My family and I object to the proposed Boundary Commission move of Nash and Boraston to the Cleobury Division. There are 25 members of our family living in Nash currently and we as a group object to this proposal for the reasons listed below...

The main population and commercial centres neighbouring our parish and with whom our area mainly identify are Clee Hill and Burford. Both of these areas are currently in Clee division and will remain so even if Nash moves away as proposed.

2. Any developments or decisions affecting either Clee Hill and/or Burford have a direct bearing on the interests of Nash civil parish and in order to keep abreast of such matters and to enable us to easily reflect any concerns or input we may wish to put forward regarding such decisions or developments requires us to have continuity of representation across the area.

3. The 5 mile route between Clee Hill, Knowle, Nash and Burford forms a natural corridor of villages, hamlets and individual dwellings and should have the same representation at local government level.

4. Our health, education, sports, recreational and transport needs are, in the main, linked to Clee Hill and Burford/Tenbury and our County Council representation should also represent these areas where possible for effective local government.

5. Our major employment area locally is in Burford which is in Clee division.

6. The schools, doctors, dentists, shops, pubs and food outlets serving Nash are mainly in Clee Hill

and Burford/Tenbury just 2.5 miles from Nash whereas Cleobury Mortimer is some 8 miles distant with no easy transport links and as far away as Ludlow.

7. Our community, sports and recreational facilities are located in Clee Hill, Nash and Burford/Tenbury.

8. It seems unlikely that we would get as much first hand contact with our Shropshire Councillor as we have enjoyed in the past in view of our distant location from Cleobury Mortimer.
