Dear Sirs,

I understand that there is a proposal from Shropshire Council, the Local Government Boundary Commission for England that our parish of Nash will no longer come under the Councillor for Clee Hill but be moved so that we would be represented by the Councillor for Cleobury Mortimer and I am writing to object in the strongest terms.

Nash is much closer to Clee Hill than Cleobury Mortimer which is about 8 miles away and is not our nearest town. Most of the services and facilities are in Tenbury Wells and therefore I do not think that a Cleobury Mortimer Councillor can represent us fairly.

At a recent voluntary vote, there was unanimous support for the parish to remain in the Clee Hill Councillor's remit.
