Related subject: Nash Civil Parish

I object strongly to the parish of Nash (of which I am a resident) being moved from Clee division to Cleobury Mortimer division for local council representation on Shropshire Council.

The communities of Clee Hill, Nash and Burford have strong geographic, cultural, recreational and economic links and it is vitally important that our areas share common representation at local government level to maintain community identity and effective local government.

Moving divisions risks drowning out the voices of Nash residents among those of Cleobury who do not share the same links to this rural area. For example the children of Nash Parish fall within the catchment areas of Burford or Clee Hill Primary Schools, moving divisions creates a divide between residents and schools and removes our representation in the area of which we access services most.

I also find it to be very remiss that you do not mention Nash parish by name in your report, the changes proposed are only discoverable via the map which is not easy to use. This change seems to have little to do with the views or needs of Nash Parish and more to do with filling up the electorate numbers for Cleobury Mortimer. I strongly believe Nash should remain part of the Clee division and I would like to know the justification used for the proposed move as it is not contained anywhere in your report.
