It is unusual to have two large wards stretching from Worcester all the way to the south of the County, Croome and Powick. This is particulalry unusual with the Powick Division. Consideration should be given to creating a Division in the South, to include Welland, Longdon, Eldersfield and neighbouring parishes, centred on Upton, with perhaps Hanley Castle parish and Ripple included if the numbers are necessary. Powick could gain areas from further northern divisions. Croome is growing extensively in the north of the Division and could probably be justified size wise based on population growth. The parishes in the South of the Malvern Hills District have more in common with each other than with Powick and Kempsey, which are increasingly commuter settlements for Worcester.
