I believe that Coppice Farm should all sit under the same council as at present residents either pay their council tax to Walsall or to Wolverhampton Council. I live in the area (Walsall) but have never felt part of Walsall as any events over the years have never come as far as Coppice mainly being held in other areas of Walsall. I feel that we are the forgotten area even though we pay our council tax to Walsall. However, wolverhampton does consider their residents borough wise so incorporate Ashmore (neighbouring area to Coppice) in events, etc. which means that I feel closer to Wolverhampton I know more about what's happening over the border and their councillors keep residents informed which I am able to benefit from in contrast to councillors covering Coppice Farm are never seen or heard of and further don't respond to e-mails. Suffice to say Coppice Farm would benefit from becoming part of Wednesfield, Wolverhampton in my view. I have lived in the area for over 40 years and Coppice Farm has always been excluded from Walsall decision making. Some changes were in recent years made on Coppice field which were paid by charitable donations following the death of a local child not planned or paid for by the council. Some items supplied as result of the child's death were benches and bins, which to my mind should already have been in place. When I was recovering from stroke I had nowhere to sit, same for elderly in area or anyone wanting to watch their children play football, etc. I wonder who will maintain the benches, bins and football posts given by the child's charity especially as they were not supplied by the council. I could list more concerns but I won't. I hope this helps. Thank you.
