Related subject: Runnymede, Elmbridge & Guildford

-I disagree with the name of the Thorpe, Longcross & Ottershaw division name. I suggest that the Thorpe, Longcross & Ottershaw division be renamed to Thorpe, Lyne & Ottershaw, Thorpe, Foxhills & Ottershaw or Thorpe & Foxhills. Lyne has a higher population & is more well known than Longcross, as well as being the location of the polling station for many electors. It is also more central to the division and has more amenities compared to Longcross, such as a church, parks, foxhills hotel. The foxhill name might be fitting too because it is a famous landmark in the area, however the Thorpe, Lyne & Ottershaw name would still be preferable to me.

- I disagree with the Woodham & New Haw division name. I also suggest that Woodham & New Haw be renamed to Woodham, Row Town & New Haw. Row Town is quite distinct (a different 'High Street' & little connections between them other than a single, long road) from Woodham & New Haw, two areas which pretty much merge in to each other.

-I disagree with the Horsleys & Shere divisions. Although I am not a local resident, the Shere division seems to divide the Clandon community. A better suggestion could be that M5 (Effingham Junction), N1 (Effingham North), N2 (Effingham South) districts (as well as the Southern bits of M7 (East Horsley South) & M3 (West Horsley South) to form a continuous new boundary- i.e. Green Dene Road until Crock North Road & The whole of Crock North Road) should join the Shere division to create a Shere & Effingham Division and then West Clandon & Send can join the Horsleys division to create a Clandon & Horsley division as these areas seem to look towards each other more and this may divide less communities.

-I disagree with the Shalford division name. Again, this isn't coming from a Guildford Resident, but the Shalford Division seems to not be named

to represent all communities: Tongham is a completely different area to shalford, for example. It could be given a more generic name like "Guildford Southern Villages", "Guildford Rural" or place names like "Shalford & Tongham" or "Shalford, Compton & Tongham"

-I disagree with the Oxshott division between divisions. Although I am not an Elmbridge resident (anymore), I feel an oxshott divide should be avoided but I am not too sure how this could be done. I agree with the West & East Molsey divisions much more now than the current situation though.

-I disagree with the Addlestone division boundaries. Although I cannot think of a better solution, the CR3 Polling district should be kept out of the Addlestone division since it does not look towards Addlestone, but Chertsey instead. I also beleive that Chertsey High School should be put into the Chertsey division as it would make sense for the councillor of the area to have the local school for Chertsey in their division, although the rest of the CR1 district is fine in the Addlestone division as the area at least some what looks towards addlestone culturally (hence the biggest settlement in CR1 being 'Addlestonemoor').
