## Comment text:

I understand that the Boundary Commission is considering changing the electoral boundaries so that East Molesey would no longer be conjoined with Esher for Surrey County Council elections. The existing arrangement is nonsensical since East Molesey does not adjoin Esher at any point. I therefore fully support the proposal to combine East Molesey with Thames Ditton for County elections. You will be aware that a large part of East Molesey already votes as part of Thames Ditton for Elmbridge Borough elections.

East Molesey abuts Thames Ditton across a long section of Hampton Court Way with convenient crossings at Summer Road and Embercourt Road.

There are many facilities on both sides of Hampton Court Way which are used equally by East Molesey and Thames Ditton residents, such as the Sixth Form College, the Metropolitan Police Social and Sports Club at Imber Court, Glenlyn Medical Centre (which has interchangeable facilities in East Molesey and Thames Ditton), the Skiff Club, St Paul's Roman Catholic Church and many pubs, cafes and restaurants in both areas.

I conclude that the proposed change would be logical and representative of the many community links between the two areas - unlike the present arrangement with Esher. I therefore strongly support the proposed change.
