Related subject: Oxshott Boundary Changes

I reject the recommendations of LGBCE for its proposed division of Oxshott and its community of about 5,000+ people. Currently Oxshott has its surrounding Green Belt, its own High Street, its own medical centre, its own schools, and its own station. There can be no justification for dividing the community for any reason, and particularly by arbitrarily drawing a line down a main road. There can be no justification for the obliteration of the name of Oxshott in the LGBCE recommendations.

The proposal recommends according to Oxshott an orphan status whose population can be conveniently carved up to suit LGBCE's arithmetical requirements. It sacrifices the concept of community and is frankly disrespectful to the residents of Oxshott. I therefore politely request LGBCE to revise its recommendations on a basis that properly respects the second key consideration of LGBCE of "Ensuring that the recommendations reflect community identity". In my view this can best be done by retaining the existing boundaries whereby Oxshott continues to be part of the division of Hinchley Wood, Claygate & Oxshott.
