As a resident of Oxshott who has lived in the village for over 30 years I was shocked by the recently disclosed papers that suggest that Oxshott as a village would disappear and be redistributed rather summarily to neighbouring villages; the demarcation as I read these proposals being a simple line along a main road.

There is significant history in Oxshott that has been owned by its residents, including care for the Heath, recent major improvement to the Church and currently its associated Hall and grounds; which have stood on its existing site for over 100 years. All these have a direct positive benefit to our community and alongside the Oxshott Club, and Village Sports Club, Schools, Shops and Pubs and Restaurants create a village with a true identity. This is not just for those who live here but also many visitors travelling to enjoy these facilities and countryside via our own Railway Station.

Despite the demographic wealth there remain local Charities who work closely with the poor and needyist of our community and that kind of neighbourly concern for those less fortunate gets left behind by these administrative changes.

I urge the LBGCE to reflect again on this proposal and retain Oxshott not just as a name but a caring Village and plays its active part in the wider local community
