Oxshott was first recorded as a hamlet in 1179 and has existed and grown to its present size over the following 844 years. It has a distinct character and boundaries which create a clear community identity. It also has an effective community organisation FEDORA which speaks for the residents of Oxshott.

It also has a distinct set of concerns in regard to its environment, largely because it is surrounded almost completely by green belt and yet has an A class road running through the village centre.

Splitting Oxshott into two halves and putting one half of Oxshott into Cobham and the other into Esher and Claygate and removing its name from either of the new areas is an act of historical vandalism and community destruction. Oxshott should remain as one coherent unit with clear community identity and interests and any problems with electoral equality should be resolved in some other way, or ignored.
