**Related subject:** Oxshott (in Elmbridge)

The identity and interests of beautiful, semi-rural green Oxshott need to be duly recognised. This is a statutory requirement that the proposals for change do not recognise. The new Elmbridge Local Plan Design Code accurately assess Oxshott as a village surrounded by Green Belt - with settlements on the village's Green Belt boundaries being described as genuinely semi-rural : not suburban like the rest of Elmbridge. In order to save and enhance the green character of Oxshott, Surrey County Council's Division boundary should not divide Oxshott. The existing Division boundary for Oxshott, Claygate, Hinchley Wood Division should therefore be kept - not altered. This is the only way to protect and enhance our village. My house is directly on the boundary of Oxshott Green Belt Sub-Area 11, which The Crown Estate/Savills is promoting for development. 2544 of us have signed the [www.change.org.uk](http://www.change.org.uk) petition, available on the @BluWavOxshott Twitter account. I am a founder and leader of the BluWav residents group working to save the Green Belt surrounding Oxshott. The BluWav residents group is a member group of FEDORA residents association.
