Related subject: in response to "We propose a Cobham division and an Esher & Claygate division with the boundary between the two running from the A3 south along the edge of Oxshott Heath, north-east along the railway line, and south along the A244 Warren Lane/Leatherhead

This suggestion fails to recognise the existence of Oxshott as a village and a community. By placing the boundary along the A244, you are splitting Oxshott in two. Both sides of the road have a common identity and interests. This I particularly so in the case of road and infrastructure projects, notably traffic on the A244 and planning matters including anything on the high street where each side of the road would be in different divisions. The proposed change would massively reduce local representation, leaving Oxshott as an afterthought on the edge of divisions
