## Comment text:

I have read the consultation on the above and feel that the proposals will make things worse than they are now in your three criteria of: Electoral equality; Community identity and interests; and Effective and convenient local government.

My understanding is that the existing split of Divisions actually give more electoral equality than the Commission's proposals. This makes no sense and does not move us nearer to equality.

The Thames Ditton & Weston Green Residents' Association has been in place for a long time and Weston Green residents feel part of Thames Ditton and Thames Ditton and Long Ditton are closely linked and served by a single County Councillor and the two Residents' Associations work closely together. I feel nothing in common with Hinchley Wood, which is physically separated by the Portsmouth Road and the huge roundabout. This proposal would result in two County Councillors serving our community. The current division boundary is clear and familiar to residents and, most importantly, it works. This is why I believe Surrey County Council themselves did not propose any major change.
