I am the Kent County Councillor for Canterbury South and the Canterbury City Councillor for Nailbourne Ward.

When there was last a review I put forward the proposal to create the single member wards of Nailbourne and Little Stour & Adisham. I believe that both of these wards are within the elector numbers still, and the arguments still hold for this wards to remain exactly as they are. I would particularly argue that because of the large geographical size of this wards, that they remain as single member wards and are NOT combined into a two-member ward.

My county council division also includes about half of the large two member Chartham & Stone Street ward. Chartham is now also a small town and has little in common with the villages in the ward.

I don't know how the numbers would work, but Chartham could have it's own ward, and the villages to the south their own, perhaps also taking in the New House Lane parished ward part of the Thanington Parish joining Petham, Waltham, Upper Hardres & Lower Hardres in another ward, that would make sense.
