It seems from the figures for electorate numbers now and projected to 2029, that the "excess numbers" in Blythe Ward, as currently defined, needs to be addressed. Considering geographically adjacent wards to Blythe, it is also to be noted that, Dorridge and Hockley Heath ward has a "deficit in numbers". So the easiest and most sensible approach to rebalancing electorate numbers would be to move part or most of the excess from Blythe into Dorridge and Hockley Heath. Other adjacent wards do not appear to have a deficit in numbers (now and projected to 2029) to allow movement from Blythe ward into these wards (namely Shirley South and St. Alphege) for rebalancing purposes.
