**Related subject:** Boundary commission: Trinity ward

Trinity is an intrinsic part of Stroud town with numerous key buildings and facilities that make it part of the town. Stroud central should be left as a unified entity rather than to undermine the representative role that is long been established in treating Stroud as an accountable place whose representative is best able to deal with the requirements of Trinity ward as part of an established Stroud central division.
