and Kidderminster Town Parish wards**

Please accept this submission on behalf of the Wyre Forest Conservative Association (WFCA) in respect of the consultation which is currently being undertaken by the Local Government Boundary Commission.

Worcestershire County Council Divisions

WFCA agree and welcome that Wyre Forest will continue to be represented at County Hall by 10 Local Government representatives, and additionally support the proposal for Stourport to be divided into 2 divisions rather than the current 2 representatives in one large division. WFCA has no objections to the revised boundaries, welcomes the stronger boundary division lines and the new proposed Division for the renamed St Peters, which previously as St Marys, was electorally larger than other divisions. This new proposal, we believe, provides a fairer electoral equality for the residents within the Wyre Forest area.

Kidderminster Town Council

WFCA sees no benefit to the proposals in this consultation, the representation would be unequal and confusing. It is believed that the status quo should remain, which is coterminous with the Town's District Wards and provides good representation to and for the community.
