**Related subject:** Alvechurch, Barnt green and Wythall

Alvechurch and Barnt Green are two historic villages, a mile apart and surrounded by green belt and with no bus services. Wythall by contrast, is several miles distant from Alvechurch and Barnt Green, through green belt and is an urban area connected to Birmingham physically as well through transport links. They could not be more different. This shows in, for example, sadly through crime rates. if a two councillor division is constructed as suggested, almost certainly the two councillors would split their responsibilities into Alvechurch/ Barnt green for one and the other Wythall. Your population calculation should not override the common sense approach to having two separate councillors, reflecting the natural existing divisions.
