The time this has taken, the effort involved and the cost is not worth it. How much has it cost to get to this stage for a small area?

Putting the time, effort and cost to one side, historically and physically, Harvington is far closer distance wise to Evesham than Droitwich and in terms of distance it is closer still to the Warwickshire boundary.

Evesham is a town of immense historical importance in the history of England and Harvington adds extra support on this - just look at the recent archaeological finds.

Turning to the population's cohesion, residents in Harvington shop in Evesham or Alcester/Bidford for the most part; health services are found in either Evesham or Bidford; and schooling is either Evesham or Alcester. The reasoned connectivity is there and long established without inserting
