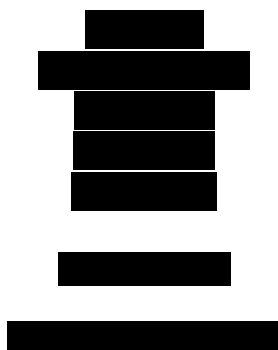

Ref. Proposed Ward changes to Kington and Dormston

Sir.

Kington and Dormston Parish are currently aligned with the Upton Snodsbury Ward. The Parish has many links to Upton Snodsbury Ward including the local school at Flyford Flavell and the shared troublesome main Road, namely the A422, with issues including speeding, nuisance motor cycles and fatal and serious accidents. Both Parish Councils have worked together on issues such as the A422 and rural crime. Kington and Dormston Parish can identify more with the smaller local villages and farming communities, as they do currently.

Kington and Dormston Parish was recently aligned with Inkberrow Ward, which is fast becoming a small town. Kington and Dormston Parish have little in common with Inkberrow and residents feel they are now 'small fish in a big pool'. A similar situation could occur, if we are moved from the Upton Snodsbury Ward.

Kington and Dormston Parish have little in common with Harvington Ward. Harvington ward is more of an urban area and more closely aligned to Droitwich, itself a large town locally. Kington and Dormston which mainly comprises small settlements and isolated properties, is very rural in comparison and will not be so well represented, if we are so aligned.

I do hope that The Boundary Commission will take local views into account and respect the wishes of local people.
