Related subject: Bell End Village, Belbroughton

I would like to object to proposed changes that would seek to remove Bell End Village and its surrounding areas from the Clent division. The proposed use of the A491 as a boundary would only serve to divide and separate communities and villages that are natural and interconnected neighbours and sever community ties and links. Our natural place and daily life revolves around using local amenities in Belbroughton and Clent, in particular doctors, schools, the rec, tennis club and local shops and pubs. Our ties and social activities naturally take us to Belbroughton. Where we live is physically at the foot of Clent and the wider area which we are regularly and easily able to access. Our area is so closely linked physically and as part of a rural community that it needs to be looked at and remain part of the interconnecting villages of Belbroughton and Clent to ensure that the whole area is considered as one. To simply remove a portion of the area and artificially put it into the area of Woodvale would have no benefit and would adversely sever ties as there is no physical or community connection with any of those areas. Our lives and the place where we live and interconnect with should not be removed simply to try and achieve the proposed objective at the expense of other things which are far more important locally, and that the electorate in our area are best served by remaining within the existing Clent division.
