I would like to object to the proposed changes that would seek to remove Bell End Village and its surrounding areas from the Clent division. Having lived here for nearly 20 years there is a very strong sense of community ties with Belbroughton, and the proposed use of the A491 as a boundary would only serve to sever those community ties.
